£100 REWARD—WILFUL MURDER.

JOHN PENNINGTON *alias* HENRY WILSON, a sailor, stands charged with the wilful murder of Eliza Jones, at Liverpool, on the 30th April, 1863. Description at that time,—about 30 years of age, 5 feet 4 inches high, proportionate make, dark swarthy complexion, thin face, whiskers shaved off as far as the chin which is covered with long black strong hair coming down to his breast, black moustache, all of which he may shave off, black curly hair, rather a sneering manner when speaking, has a rolling or swaggering gait in his walk, has a ring in Indian ink on third finger right hand, and bracelet on one or both wrists, supposed to be red and blue, large ship on breast, and flags and anchors on arms; has sailed under various names.
