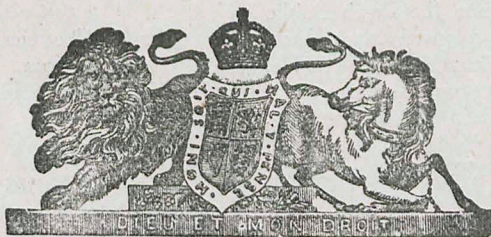

MURDER.
